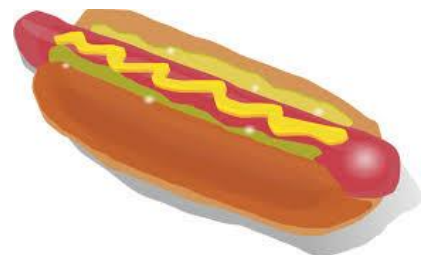
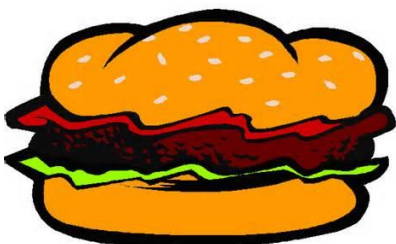


**Grandview Parade
